



Dr. Victor A. Markovich is professor of music, and director of bands and wind/percussion studies at the Wichita State University (WSU) School of Music. He received the Doctor of Philosophy with an emphasis in music education and wind/band conducting and Master of Music degrees from The University of Michigan (Ann Arbor, Michigan). He holds a Bachelor of Music degree from Kent State University (Kent, Ohio) and has done additional study at Bowling Green State University (Bowling Green, Ohio) and The Cleveland Institute of Music.

His bands have performed for numerous national, regional, and state conventions.
