Our audition process will be very similar to last year:

\*You may submit one or two balanced quartets.

\*If you are interested in sending singers and you do not have a quality balanced quartet, please email me at [mschoir@sckmea.org](mailto:mschoir@sckmea.org) and I will attempt to complete your quartet with students from other schools. Please make sure "extra" singers know that if quartets cannot be balanced, they may not be chosen.

\*Please be aware; INCOMPLETE QUARTETS completed on the online registration form will NOT be accepted unless first approved by SCKMEA.

\*Please watch the website for more information on this.

There will be an on-line form to fill out when the time gets closer. (Please read the directions carefully) The deadline for registration is September 26. A master practice cd will be sent to you following registration.

The event will be held at Andover Central High School on November 5th. The cost is \$10 per student and that covers lunch as well. Please make sure your checks are sent to Larry Brownlee (SCKMEA Executive Secretary) and that SCKMEA MSChoir is in the memo.
